

# Painting Flowers from Life in Oil With Andrew Bonneau

#### **Materials List**

#### **Materials to bring:**

#### Paint -

Artist quality oil colour -

White- lead, flake or titanium
Yellow ochre
Cadmium orange
Cadmium yellow light or mid
Raw sienna
Cadmium red light or scarlet
Alizarin Crimson
Terra rosa, Venetian red or Indian red
Burnt sienna
Ultramarine blue
Phthalo blue
Ivory black
Burnt umber
Raw umber

### Canvas-

A fine grade of primed white linen or cotton canvas is recommended; otherwise a primed board. The idea is to have minimal texture.

Andrew would recommend toning it with a very light grey or brown oil paint (eg.. burnt umber with white) about a week before the workshop.

Around 8 x 10, 9 x 12 inches or similar would be suitable

## **Brushes-**

A selection of various sized sable or synthetic brushes are recommended.

Palette knife

Palette (wooden is recommended, sealed with oil or varnish)
Odourless solvent in a jar (with lid)
Small mirror
Paper towel

If you have a small vase you'd like to use, please bring it.

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
