

# Landscape Painting in Acrylics With Don Milner

# **Materials List**

#### **PAINT**

[Please Note: Don uses mostly Atelier paints for his workshops and classes, therefore, his suggested colours below have been chosen from their range]

Any artist-quality paint brands may be used, so long as the same colours are available. Don suggests that students purchase the best quality paints they can afford.

Chroma A2 or similar are ideal for Beginners and are slightly more cost-effective, However, Don does not recommend Jo Sonja or Chromacryl for his students.

### **IMPORTANT**

- \* Titanium White (Large size) Chroma A2 is ideal
- \* Cadmium Yellow "Lite or Lemon"
- \* Cadmium Yellow "Medium"
- \* Cadmium Red Light (Small Size)
- \* Permanent Alizarin
- \* Light Red Ochre
- \* Ultramarine Blue
- \* Brilliant Violet
- \* Cerulean Blue
- \* Purple (Atelier) (Must not be Dioxin Purple)
- \* Burnt Umber
- \* Burnt Sienna
- \* Yellow Ochre
- \* Atelier Clear Painting Medium
- \* Atelier 'Regular' Gel (Gloss) Medium

#### **OPTIONAL**

Cadmium Red Medium, Orange, Light Red Oxide (A2) (instead of light red ochre), Phthalo Blue, Paynes Grey, Raw Sienna, Raw Umber, Atelier Slow Medium - (Optional)

• You are welcome to bring other colours or just what they have already and we can work with those.

## **Brushes**

Hog Bristle Bright 20mm & 15mm Taklon Pointed Round 4mm Taklon Bright 12mm & 8mm NEEF 95 Bright Stiff Synthetic, #8 Fine Rigger Brush Cheap Bristle Flat 50mm

# **Drawing Materials**

Pencils 4b Kneaded Eraser Willow Charcoal Sticks 3-4mm x 2 Fine Mist Squirt Water Bottle (NOT a Garden Sprayer) Clean cotton cloth or rags

# Other

Stretched Canvas 1 x (50 x 60cm) approx. or similar

Stretched Canvas 1 x (30 x 40cm) approx. or slightly smaller for exercises

25mm (W) Roll of Masking Tape

Box of Tissues

Two old towels

Painting Knife for mixing

2 x Water Container (Ice-Cream containers) or 2 Small Plastic Buckets + Dish Washing Liquid Suitable Palette or 6 x White Plastic Dinner Plates (Must have smooth bases)

Clothing should be comfortable and suitable for painting in Bienarté will provide an easel Don supplies appropriate Photographic Reference (where applicable)

Students may already have most of these items and colours but if you cannot acquire them, just bring what you have already and Don will work with it.
